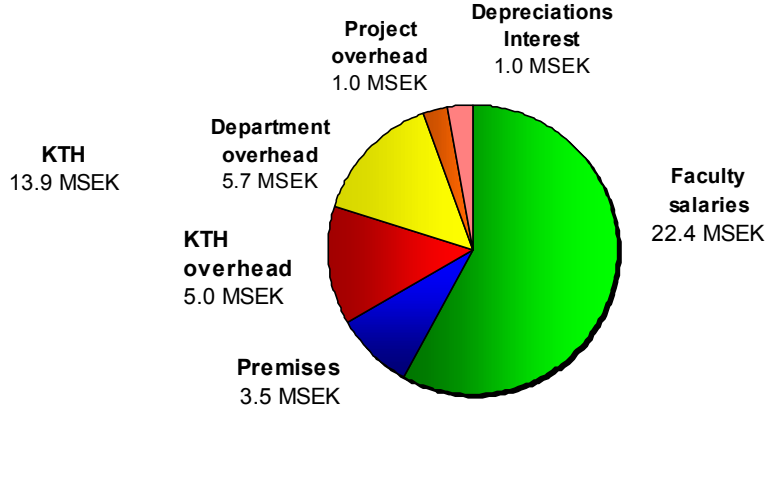
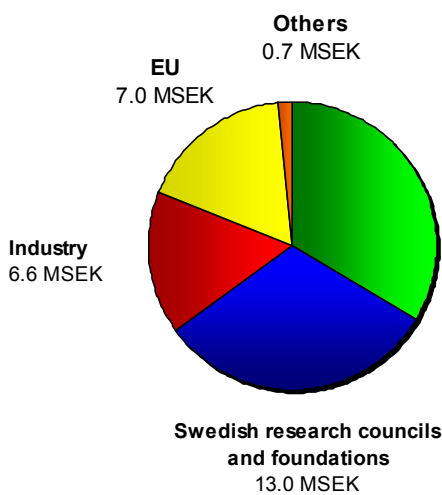


## Finances

The total turnover during 2002 for the department and the Centre of Speech Technology (CTT) was 38.8 MSEK. The centre is a joint venture in which industrial partners, the Swedish Board for Industrial and Technical Development, Vinnova and KTH take equal shares. The department has a mixed portfolio with external financiers, including eight Swedish research councils and foundations, the two major Swedish telecom companies Ericsson and Telia, several companies in The

Netherlands, Japan and USA, and the European Commission. The funding of the activities was dominated by KTH (13.9 MSEK) closely followed by Swedish research councils and foundations (13.0 MSEK). EU-projects are an important part of our activity, contributing 7.0 MSEK. Swedish and international industry, mainly in the telecom field, invested 6.6 MSEK in our research projects. The total external funding amounted to 66%.

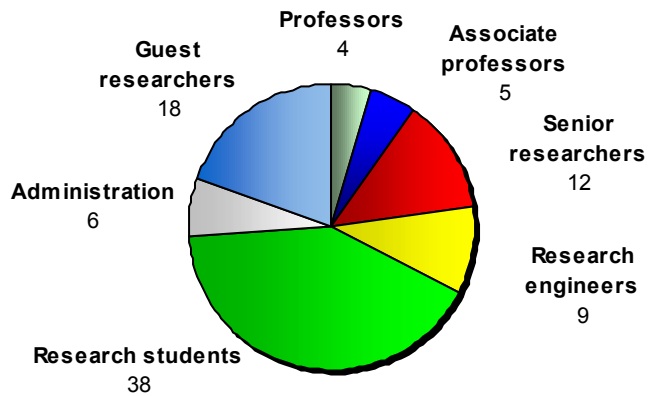
